## Heraldry & Genealogy Society of Canberra membership benefits

- Access our library for free during opening hours: The library hours are listed on the back of the membership card and on the website. The Library Collection, with about 20,000 publications, is one of the largest genealogical collections in Australia and has a wide range of research material, particularly for Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, and Ireland. We also hold a major collection of material on Heraldry. The collection is in the form of books and journals, microfilm and microfiche, manuscripts and computer-based indexes and records, including in-house databases not available elsewhere.
- Receive our journal *The Ancestral Searcher*: The journal is published 4 times per year and includes articles of interest to family historians, diary dates for our social and education programs and news of what is happening in the Society. The editor is Rosemary McKenzie. Contributions from members are always welcome and should be addressed to the Editor or e-mailed to [editor@familyhistoryact.org.au](mailto:editor@familyhistoryact.org.au).
- Attend monthly meetings with guest speakers: Monthly meetings of the Society are held on the first Tuesday of each month except January, in the Education Room of the HAGSOC Library, Cook commencing at 7:00pm, and take the form of talks by guest speakers with expertise in various fields of genealogy, family history and heraldry.
- Attend educational programs throughout the year: The Society provides its members with regular opportunities to increase their knowledge and skills in heraldry, genealogy and family history. This is done through a series of Education Programs usually, but not always, conducted by members for members.
- Receive free research advice to members for those facing an apparent 'brick wall': The Research Officer also undertakes research using the Society's wide resources for Society members who live away from Canberra.
- Receive a 10% discount when purchasing books published by the Society: The Society publishes many collections of monumental inscriptions from cemeteries around the district. Refer to the publications list on the website or in the library.
- Participate in any or all Special Interest Groups and other Groups active within the Society: These provide more specialised assistance and support to members on various topics. Members may attend any or all of the meetings without additional cost. If tea or coffee is provided a gold coin donation would be appreciated.
- Reciprocal library access arrangements with State organisations: The Heraldry & Genealogy Society of Canberra (HAGSOC) has reciprocal arrangements with a number of Australian and New Zealand family history societies.
